

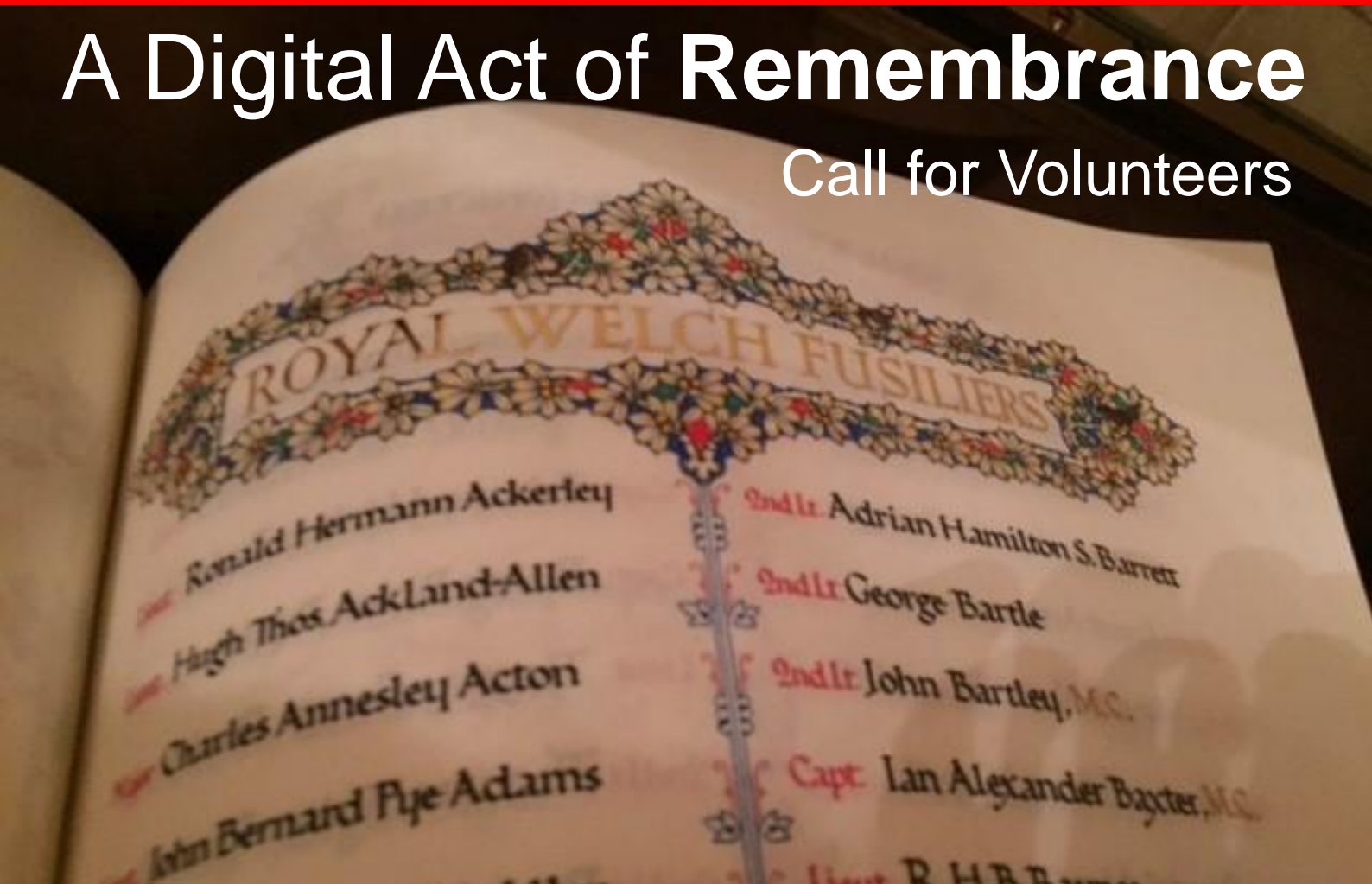

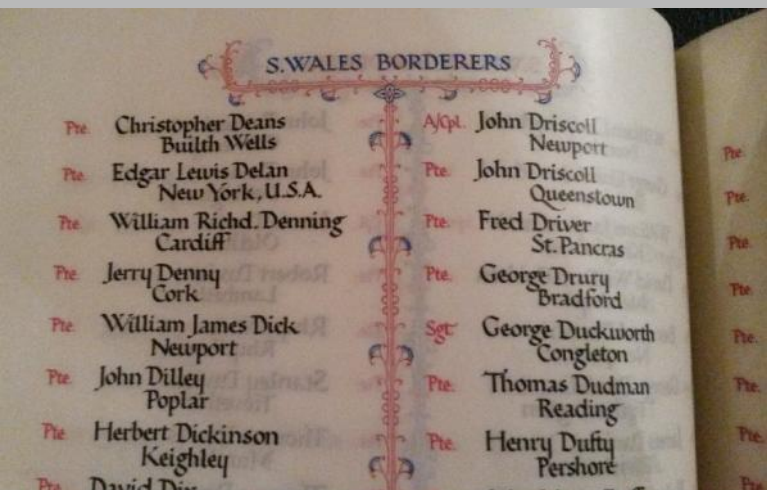


## Take part in a national act of 'digital remembrance' for the fallen of the First World War: could your community group help?

The **Welsh National Book of Remembrance** for the First World War holds the names of 35,000 service personnel of Welsh birth or parentage who died, and we'd like your help to **remember every one of them**.

Since 1938, the Book has been held in the Temple of Peace and Health, in Cathays Park, Cardiff in a purpose-built crypt, to serve as a reminder of the horror of war and the importance of striving for peace.

So that each and every name can be found, researched and remembered, we need to transcribe the Book. This means entering each name into a database, tagging it with key information as listed (regiment, town of birth . . .), and publishing this so that generations to come can 'search' the Book in a way that is impossible at the moment. It's a really simple process – each name should only take a minute or so to enter. Who knows? You may come across the name of a member of your family . . . or someone from your community. What better way to **#RememberforPeace**?

### To arrange a transcription session

The Wales for Peace team can support your community group with a workshop giving a background to the Book, and basic training to be able to start transcribing. We can support an hour's transcription for a group of up to 15 people, answering any queries that arise along the way. Although we can provide 2-3 laptops where needed, we would be grateful if transcription volunteers can bring a laptop with Google Chrome browser (to use the transcription tool) and WiFi-enabled internet access. We can help groups to find suitable local venues (with WiFi and ICT access) for enable volunteers to get the most from the transcription session.

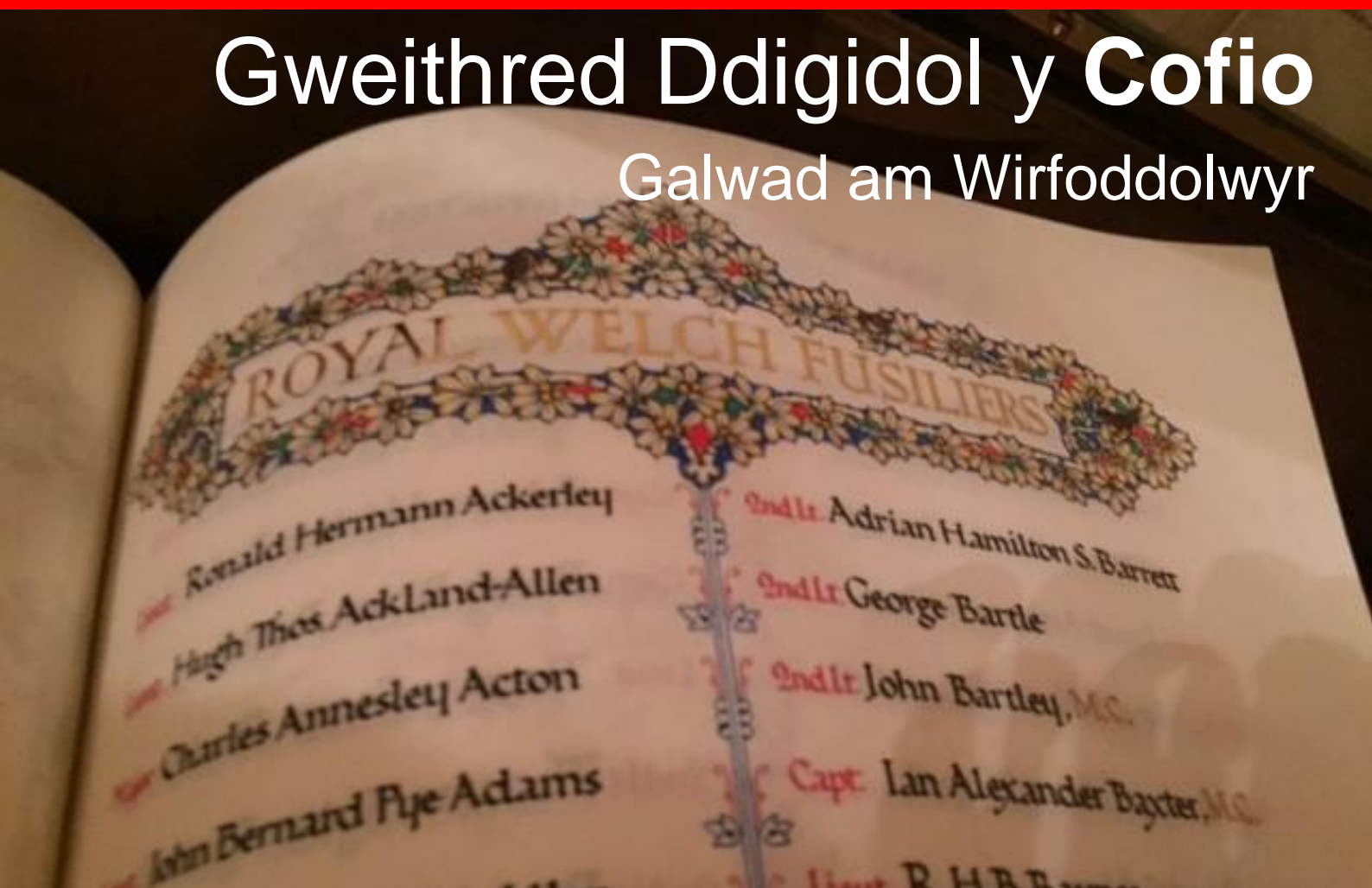

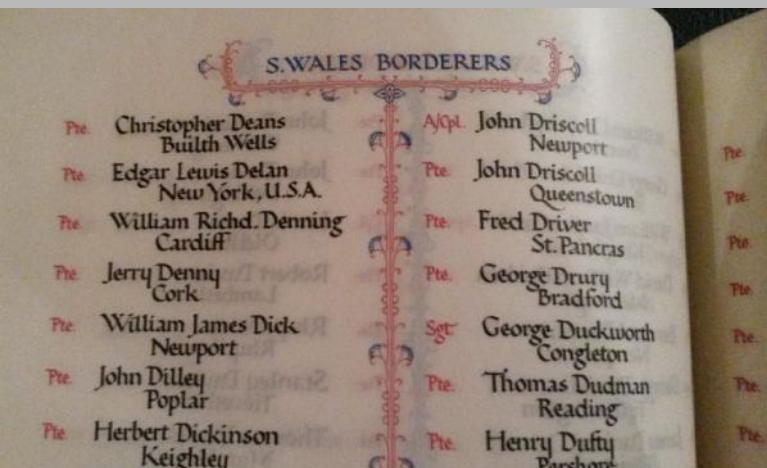

Ers 1938, mae'r Llyfr wedi cael ei gadw yn y Deml Heddwch a lechyd ym Mharc Cathays, Caerdydd mewn crypt pwrpasol, i'n hatgoffa am erchyllterau rhyfel a phwysigrwydd ymdrechu am heddwch.

Er mwyn gallu dod o hyd i bob enw, ymchwilio am bob enw a chofio am bob un unigolyn, mae angen i ni drawsgrifio'r Llyfr.
